Bank of Italy Gender Economics Workshop Rome – June 23, 2023

Submission Deadline: 6 pm April 3, 2023

The Bank of Italy Gender Economics Workshop will take place in Rome on June 23, 2023. The aim of the workshop is to bring together leading and emerging economists working on topics related to gender economics, with a particular focus on the policy implications to tackle gender inequalities.

In particular, we welcome both theoretical and empirical submissions on:

- The contribution of women to overall economic growth and business cycle dynamics.
- Gender wage gaps: differences in firm-level wage setting, bargaining power, negotiation skills.
- The child penalty and its sources; the role of family-friendly policies.
- Gender gaps in human capital accumulation, the role of fields of study and school performance.
- Glass ceiling and the effectiveness of gender quotas.
- Social transfers and economic incentives to improve women labour market outcomes and foster overall economic growth.

The keynote speaker will be Patricia Cortes (Boston University).

Funding

The workshop will take place in the Bank of Italy headquarter in Rome. Financial support to all speakers for economy class air travel and 1-night hotel accommodation (2 nights for non-European travelers) will be provided. However, due to the uncertainty of the COVID-19 situation and to possible travel restrictions, the workshop may become fully online or a hybrid in-presence-virtual workshop.
